Triunfo Water & Sanitation District Schedules Free Class on Landscaping for Fire - 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, November 2, in Oak Park

VENTURA, Calif., October 8, 2019 – Triunfo Water & Sanitation District will sponsor a Landscaping for Fire class on Saturday morning, November 2, from 10:00 to 11:30 at the Mae Boyar recreation facility (130 Kanan Road in Oak Park). The class is free and open to the public, although priority registration will be given to customers of Triunfo Water & Sanitation District.

The training will be conducted by an instructor from the University of California Master Gardener Program and will cover topics including defensible space zones, effective use of hardscape materials, vertical clearance for trees and shrubs, dealing with slopes, plants to avoid, and fire-wise plant characteristics. The class is particularly timely, coming almost a year after the Woolsey Fire swept through the Oak Park area, causing significant damage to local hillsides and residential properties.
